Located amid 32 acres of scenic woodlands along the banks of the Saugatuck River, Camp Mahackeno is part of Westport history. Founded in 1938 as a “stay at home camp” for boys, today our camp features an array of amenities and programs for boys and girls, including a large outdoor swimming pool, 12-acre pond for canoeing and fishing, playing fields, rock wall for climbing and plenty of space for such traditional camp activities as archery, leather making and arts and crafts.



We offer four two-week sessions for campers entering grades 1 through 10, as well as a Special Events Week, held after the regular camp season (August 20-24). Camp Mahackeno is divided into units designed to give age-appropriate levels of supervision and camp activity.

Behind all of the fun at camp is a staff that cares a great deal about keeping campers safe and secure as they play, explore, try and succeed. Our programs are balanced to meet the needs of each camper, including our Special Cares program for children with special needs.
